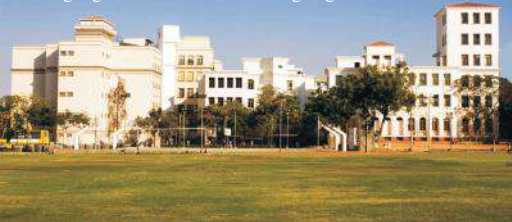

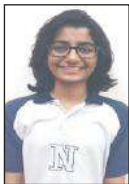
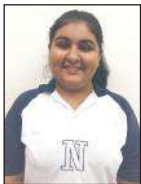
# Indo Nepal International Skating Championship
