Pre- Primary

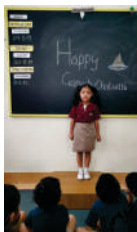
A show and tell activity was conducted on August 26, 2019 for Nursery class where children brought their favorite vegetable and spoke a few lines about it.

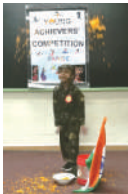
Jr. Kg children learned the skill of decorating muffins on August 20, 2019 after observing the demonstration done by the teacher. They relished muffins they had decorated.

Group Activity

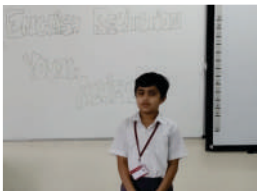
Grade II

Grade 4

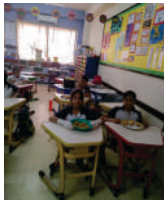

Art and Craft Club

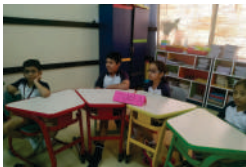
Grade 4
